

The Easter Meeting 11th . 13th April 2009

Conditions of entry

1. Competitors must be in possession of a valid Certificate of Competence issued by either their NRA or Primary Club. These cards must also be carried on the firing point. Spot checks will be made by the NRA. Those without cards will not be permitted to collect their squadding cards or shoot.
2. Competitions are open to members of the NRA or any Rifle Club affiliated to the NRA.
3. NRA regulations for the current year apply except where otherwise stated.
4. Only Target Rifles conforming to NRA TR specification may be used.
5. Ammunition will be provided except where competitors provide their own (see entry form). High quality 7.62mm Ammunition using 155 grain bullets will be used for the Target Rifle events. The Surrey Rifle Association cannot accept any liability for a competitor using ammunition not suited to their rifle. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their equipment conforms to the regulations. See NRA rules.
6. Sighters are convertible for all competitions. All unused sighters and spent brass must be returned. Non-compliance will incur further charges, forfeiting the ammunition discount.
7. Carton bulls are scored as Vs and are used to differentiate between scores in the first instance. In prize lists, counting out is first by total V bulls, and second by counting back on ranges and shot values as per current NRA rules. In the event of there still being a tie, prizes will be shared.
8. Cards will be available from the Surrey Hut from 8.00pm on Friday 10th April. Ammunition may be collected on the day that it is to be used.
9. TR competitors are grouped in four classes according to their status at 1st January 2009 as follows:

X	As NRA TR class X
A	As NRA TR class A
O	Not X, A or T
T	Never been in prize lists except those reserved for class D or T in a TR open meeting.
10. If an entry cannot be accepted, the applicant will be informed. Otherwise, no acknowledgement or receipt will be issued unless specifically requested and provided a stamped addressed envelope is included.
11. Ranges may not necessarily be shot in the order indicated on the program.
12. The Committee reserves the right to amend these rules and the prize lists according to the number of entries received. In the event of any dispute the Committee's decision is final.

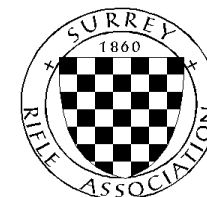
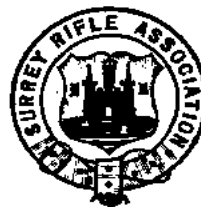
