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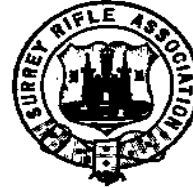

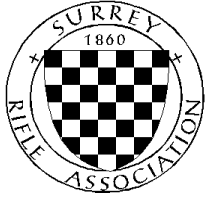

7. The Pairs

Pairs competition concurrent with Surrey Open Championship.

The pair must comprise **one Under 30 shooter and one Over 30 shooter.**

Maximum of one A class per pair. Partners can be nominated on the entry form or they will be allocated if there are no nominations. *This competition is FREE (YES – FREE!) to all those entering by the main combined entry!*

**** 1st prize £50 per pair, 2nd prize £25 per pair ****

8. Surrey Open Championship (open to all-comers)

The aggregate of competitions 1, 2 and 3

Prize list A, plus 1st: The Buck Challenge Bowl. One year's free membership for the highest scoring non-Surrey Member.

9. Surrey County Championship (closed competition)

The aggregate of competitions 1, 2 and 3. Open to members of the Association qualified to shoot for Surrey (see Condition 2 on the reverse of the entry form)

1st: The County Championship trophy, badge. The Lyford Challenge Cup will be presented to the highest scoring competitor aged 60 or over.

The Talbot-Smith Challenge Cup will be presented to the highest scoring Class D competitor.

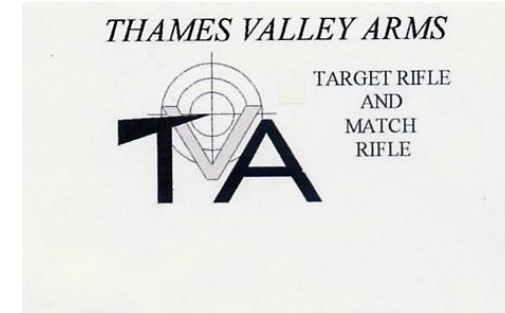
Please Note

The SRA makes every effort to mitigate the ever increasing cost of shooting. High quality match ammunition is available for this Meeting. Please ensure all converted sighters are returned so that we can continue to provide you with ongoing cost savings.

Conditions of entry

- 1.) Competitors must be in possession of a valid Certificate of Competence issued by either the NRA or their Primary Club. These cards must also be carried on the firing point. Spot checks may be made by the NRA. Those without cards will not be permitted to collect their squadding cards.
- 2.) Competitions are open to all-comers, with the exception of Competition 9, which is reserved for competitors with Surrey qualifications under Association rule 5(a) or 5(b) who are fully paid up members of the Surrey Rifle Association for the current year and who are eligible. Eligible members are defined as those who have not made themselves available for another county team in a representative match and have not shot in another county closed championship in the current year.
- 3.) NRA Target Rifle regulations for the current year apply except where otherwise stated. Individual competitions not shot under TR rules may not count towards Target Rifle Aggregates.
- 4.) TR competitors may use any ammunition up to 156 gn that complies with current NRA rules. Competitors for F Open and F/TR Classes may provide their own ammunition which complies with current NRA rules. Sighters are convertible for all competitions. All unused ammunition provided by the SRA must be returned, a condition of entry which competitors accept on signing the entry form. Non-compliance will incur an additional charge, forfeiting the reduction on the inclusive price of the Meeting entry by the competitor concerned. Furthermore, it is against the law to take ammunition issued by the SRA off Camp without that ammunition being entered by an SRA official onto Table 2 of a competitor's FAC.
- 5.) F Open and F/TR Class Competitors using HME ammunition are responsible for ensuring that they are properly zeroed prior to shooting in the Meeting.
- 6.) For first place in competitions with trophies, a tie shoot will take place where practical if two or more competitors have the same score. In prize lists, counting out is as per current NRA rules, and then by class.
- 7.) Cards and ammunition will be available from the Surrey Hut from 8.00pm on Friday 19th September.
- 8.) TR competitors are grouped in four classes according to their status at 1st January 2014 as follows:
 - A As NRA TR class X
 - B As NRA TR class A, or X in the last five years, or shooter in county / national teams in the last five
 - C Not A, B or D
 - D Never been in prize lists except those reserved for class D or Tyros in a TR open meeting
 - F F Open as defined in current NRA rules
 - F/TR F/TR as defined in current NRA rules
- 9.) **All entries must be enclosed with payment in full. No payment, no entry!** If a late entry cannot be accepted, the applicant will be informed and the monies returned. Otherwise, no acknowledgement or receipt will be issued unless specifically requested and then, only where an email address has been provided.
- 10.) Ranges may not necessarily be shot in the order indicated on the programme.
- 11.) The Committee reserves the right to amend these rules, and the prize lists according to the number of entries received. If target space restrictions are encountered, entries will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. A no-show / late cancellation by a Competitor will incur their share of target / marker and other range fees unless the vacant slot can be filled by a replacement entry.
- 12.) In the event of any dispute the Committee's decision will be final.
